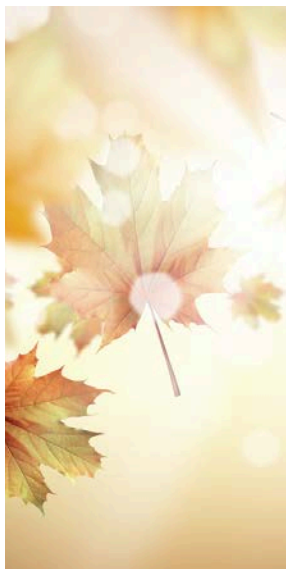

Each season, we highlight one individual who truly embodies the spirit of volunteerism, and Ron is an extraordinary example. When we started Ivins Inspired, we created a website but had no clue how to build it. Ron stepped in and created the robust framework of the site so that we could then add to it, patiently walking our team through the technology and staying available for advice and feedback ever since. Ivins City is beginning an important process of gathering data to review and update its future land use map, and we want residents to be part of the conversation!

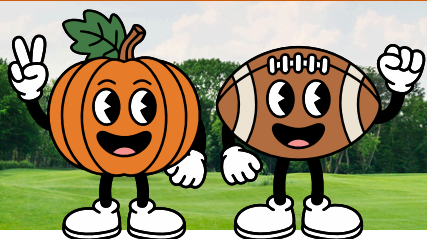
A land use map helps guide decisions about where different types of development such as homes, businesses, parks, open space, and public facilities may seem appropriate in the future. These decisions can influence the character, growth, and quality of life of Ivins for many years to come.

Your input matters. As this process begins, take some time to think about what you value most about Ivins and what you would like to see in the future. Consider questions such as:

- What do you love about Ivins that you want to preserve?
- Where does future growth make sense?
- Where should commercial development be located?
- What types of housing and businesses would benefit the community?
- Are there areas that should remain open space?
- How can we accommodate growth while maintaining the character of Ivins?

You don't need to be a planning expert to participate. You live here, and your perspective is important. Watch for announcements about upcoming City Council and Planning Commission meetings, public workshops dates, and other opportunities to provide input. Attend whenever and any way you can, ask questions, and learn about the options being considered.

Ivins No-Kill Animal Supporters (INKAS) is a 501(c)3 organization and a Registered Utah Charity. It was founded in 2010 with the mission of providing support to Ivins Animal Shelter and Adoption Center, now the Santa Clara-Ivins Animal Shelter. In 2006 our shelter became the first no-kill municipal shelter in the state of Utah. Maintaining a no-kill shelter, as opposed to one that euthanizes animals after a set period of time, is more costly because the animal's needs must be met at the shelter until they are reclaimed by their owners, adopted, or transferred to an animal rescue organization. Through a memorandum of understanding with Ivins City, INKAS provides support through veterinary care, specialty foods, and other needed supplies. Funds are gained through the donations of many generous animal lovers by donating on our website.

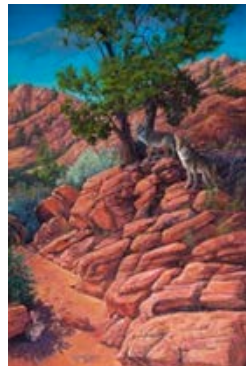
